**DECISION OF THE BOARD:** March 22, 2022

1. This is an application for accreditation made pursuant to section 134 of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, S.O. 1995, c.1, as amended (the "Act") in which the applicant seeks to be accredited as the bargaining agent of sewers and watermains employers in a manner that expands the geographic scope of its existing accreditation certification with Labourers' International Union of North America, Local 183 ("Local 183" or the "Union").

2. The Board is in receipt of a letter from counsel for Sewer Technologies Inc. ("Sewer Tech" or "ST"), dated March 21, 2022, which includes the following passage:

We are in receipt of the Board's Decision dated March 9, 2022, in which at paragraph 11 to 12 the Board directed submissions from any party in regard to submissions filed by ST and Coco Paving, as well as "other Employer Filings". ST has not, to its knowledge, been provided copies of any materials which may be relevant to any submissions, including copies of the Application, Response, all "Employer filings", and / or the submissions of Coco Paving. We have located copies of the Application and Response on the Board's website, but not the Employer filings or copies of the Coco Paving submissions. We respectfully request the Board to kindly provide copies of all such materials to the undersigned forthwith, and / or to direct the Applicant and /

or Responding Party to provide such materials to the undersigned forthwith. We also ask that the Board direct that any submissions filed by any other party on March 25, 2022 be copied to the undersigned in order for ST to respond by April 8, 2022 in accordance with the Board's direction.

3. In order to ensure that the issues identified in the Board's March 9, 2022 decision are dealt with in an expeditious manner, the Board directs the applicant to provide Sewer Tech with the materials it has requested forthwith, and further directs all other parties to copy Sewer Tech on their future submissions in this matter.
